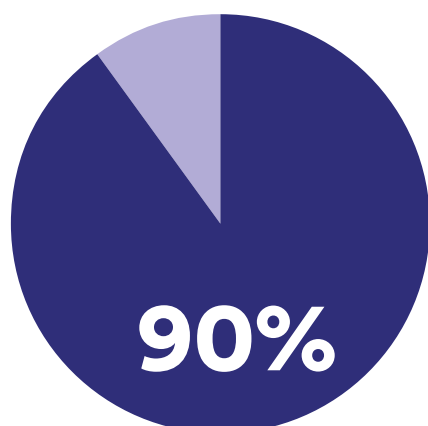
- comprises 30 questions, aligned to the Australian Professional Standards for Teachers and tailored to the remote teaching context

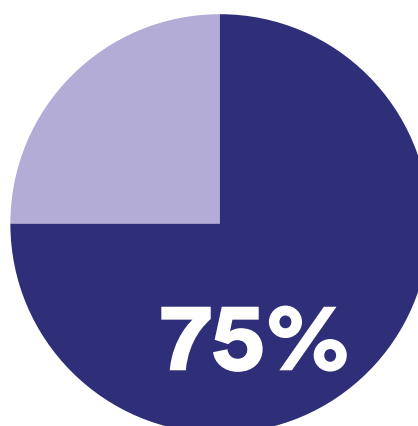
Why is student feedback so important right now?
