Pivot empowers teachers

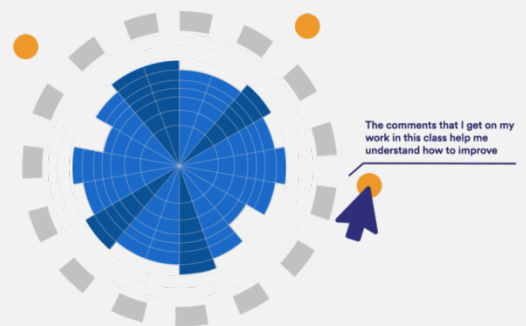

What is Pivot?

- A short, targeted Student Perception Survey on Teaching Effectiveness that can be customised to fit your school's needs.
- A platform with tools for goal-setting, observations, professional learning.
- Coaching around survey results to ensure that data is complementary to current data sources and able to be actioned.
- A platform for student voice and agency within schools and across school networks.



Implementing Pivot:

- School leaders work with Pivot coach staff to create an implementation plan for the year.
- Survey cycles are set up through our spreadsheet upload page; it takes less than 30 minutes.
- Students complete a short, 10 minute survey, normally twice a year.
- All responses to surveys are anonymous to protect the identity of students.
- Teachers and school leaders receive confidential reports as soon as each survey cycle ends.
- Pivot coaches work with school leaders to review results and identify a plan of action at the cohort, domain and whole school level.
- Teachers share their feedback with their students and colleagues to create action plans on how to improve the students' experience.
